

The net of the permanent observatories of the raptor's migration in Italy (*Infomigrans Net Italy*)

The migration of raptors in Italy is followed by a wide number of groups of observers coordinated by Universities, Parks and Conservationists Groups in different sites. Spring migration is monitored between April and June, autumn migration between August and October. The yearly results are published two times a year in the *Infomigrans Newsletter*. Data of the single sites are given as number of raptors species observed (O.Sp), Mean Number of Raptors in the last 4 (3) years (M.N.R.), most Representative Species (R.S.) with the mean number/year. For the Spring migration the principle sites are: Straits of Messina (3 years): O.Sp: 18; M.N.R.: 24.891; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (21.371). Apuane Alps: O.Sp: 13; M.N.R.: 685; R.S.: *Circaetus gallicus* (639). Mount Conero Park (AN): O.Sp: 19; M.N.R.: 3.494; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (1.800). Mount S. Bartolo Park (PS): O.Sp: 20; M.N.R.: 2.462; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (930). Pantelleria Island (South Sicily): O.Sp: 20; M.N.R.: 3.218; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (2.927). Marettimo Island (South Sicily): O.Sp: 16; M.N.R.: 1.583; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (1.347). Autumn migration: Apuane Alps: O.Sp: 16; M.N.R.: 392; R.S.: *Circaetus gallicus* (301). Tuscanian islands (Pianosa and Elba) O.Sp: 24; M.N.R.: 1.089; R.S.: *Circus aeruginosus* (809). Valle Stura (CU): O.Sp: 14; M.N.R.: 3.574; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (3.220). Po Valley (CU) (3 years): O.Sp: 12; M.N.R.: 3.139; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (3.012). Alto Garda (Brescia): O.Sp: 14; M.N.R.: 1.765; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus*. (1.760). Colli Asolani (TV): O.Sp: 16; M.N.R.: 8.212; R.S.: *Pernis apivorus* (8.152).
